
Application has been sought the information is as under:-

a.	Guideline for setting up power sub-station by the Company.	No such guidelines are available with this office, However, the applicant may read (Electricity Supply code & other conditions of Supply) regulations 2005. (66 Pages). Copy of MERC (Electricity Supply code & other conditions of Supply) regulations 2005 is available on the Commission's websites www.merc.gov.in and www.mercindia.org.in
b.	Is it mandatory to allot the space/premises for setting up power sub Station? If yes, rate of compensation offered to the Builder/ Society.	Above point is questionnaire points by which you are seeking opinion from the RTI officer. This does not come under the rights of the RTI officer. For your query, please refer MERC (Electricity Supply code & other conditions of Supply) regulations 2005.
d.	Request to organize to supply us all papers exchanged between Reliance Energy and Builder/Developer and Our housing Society for setting up power sub-station from initiation to completion.	Above point is does not come under the RTI Act, 2005.

If you require the hard copies of the aforesaid regulations, you have to deposit Rs.182/- [Rs.132/- (66 pages x Rs. 2 per page) + Rs. 50/- for postal charges] by demand draft payable at Mumbai in favour of Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission. Or you have personally visit Commission office to pay cash of Rs. 132/- and collect the aforesaid copy of regulations.

In case, if you are not satisfied with our reply, you may approach to Shri Anilkumar Ukey (Dy. Director-Legal), who is Appellate Authority, within thirty days from the receipt of the information as provided under section 19(1) of RTI Act 2005.
