Commission Order

Date: 17 March, 2015

1. Regulation 3.2 of the MERC (Fees and Charges) Regulations, 2004 states that: -

"The fees and charges payable under these regulations shall be paid by means of bank

draft or pay order, drawn in favour of the 'Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory

Commission' payable at Mumbai or may be paid in cash for an amount not exceeding

Rupees five thousand only."

2. Hence, as per the above provision the payment related to fees and charges are accepted only

through bank draft or pay order. However, M/s MSEDCL has requested the Commission

through letter dated 19.01.2015 to accept its payment through cheque or RTGS / NEFT.

3. Regulation 6 of the MERC (Fees and Charges) Regulations, 2004 provides as under:

" Power to remove difficulties: If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of

these Regulations the Commission may, be general or specific order, make such

provisions not inconsistent with the provisions of the Act, as may appear to be necessary

for removing the difficulty."

4. Taking into account the difficulty faced by applicants and in exercise of the power conferred

by Regulation 6 of the MERC (Fees and Charges) Regulations, the Commission, in addition

to modes prescribed under Regulation 3.2 of the MERC (Fees and Charges) Regulations,

2004, allows the following: -

a. Receiving of payment through RTGS/NEFT from all applicants.

Receipt issued by the Account Section will be conclusive evidence of the RTGS/NEFT payments, which will be issued on verification of credit of amount in the following bank account:
