1	Has the Maharashtra Electricity Commission permitted TATA POWER COMPANY to erect a High Tension 220 KV power transmission Tower in the premises of AMRITDHARA CO.OP HOUSING SOCIETY CHMEBUR MUMBAI- 89, such that the distance between the society's building Inclusive of window, chajja and the 220 KV conductor is less than 5.6 meters, inclusive of 3.8 meters no construction zone + 1.8 meter safe distance. If so please attach a copy of the permission order to the information provided.	The specific information asked by the applicant is not available with the Commission. The Commission approves the Capex schemes in-principally as proposed by the Transmission Licensees. As per CEA, Rules 2010, It is the responsibility of concerned Transmission Licencee to maintain the required clearances. The Electrical Inspector is the competent authority to verify the safe clearances.
