## PUBLIC NOTICE

### Inviting Comments on Application of M/s Reliance Infrastructure Ltd. for amendment of Transmission Licence under Section 18 of the Electricity Act, 2003.

1. M/s. Reliance Infrastructure Ltd. (RInfra) has applied to the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (MERC) for the following amendments to its Transmission Licence No. 1 of 2011 granted u/s 14 of the Electricity Act, 2003:
  - a. Addition of the following under the head 'Area of Transmission'- "Proposed System – List of EHV Substation Bays":
    - 6 Numbers of 220 kV Bays at 220 kV Versova EHV Substation
  - b. Modification in list of existing and proposed Transmission Lines and Bays as given at Paragraph 3 'Area of Transmission' under the head "Existing System-Transmission Lines" and "Proposed System -Transmission Lines"
2. RInfra had published a Notice in (i) Indian Express (English), (ii) Hindustan Times (English), (iii) Loksatta (Marathi) and (iv) Saamana (Marathi) on 28 February, 2017, as required under Section 18(2) (a) of the Act inviting written suggestions or objections, but none has been received.
3. The State Transmission Utility, vide its letter dated 21 March, 2017, has recommended that the Transmission Licence may be amended as proposed by RInfra.
4. The Commission is prima facie satisfied that Transmission Licence No. 1 of 2011 granted to RInfra may be amended as proposed, under the MERC (Transmission Licence Conditions) Regulations, 2004, as amended in 2006.

Comments, suggestions or objections on the proposed amendment may be filed in English or Marathi, in (6+1) copies, which should carry the full name, postal address and e-mail address, if any, of the sender and addressed to the Secretary of the Commission, personally or by post; or by Fax or e-mail [Fax: 22163976; E-mail – [mercindia@merc.gov.in](mailto:mercindia@merc.gov.in)] within thirty days from the date of publication of this Notice. It should be indicated whether the responses are being filed on behalf of any organisation or of any category of consumers. It should also be mentioned if the sender wants to be heard in person, in which case opportunity would be given by the Commission at the Public Hearing to be held on **30 May, 2017 at 11:00 hrs in the Office of the Commission at 13th Floor, Centre No. 1, World Trade Centre, Cuffe Parade, Mumbai 400 005**, when RInfra's Application for amendment of its Transmission Licence will be considered. No separate notice will be issued for the purpose.
