GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING QUOTATION

- 1. Sealed quotations are invited in the prescribed format for Supply of Stationery items to MERC Office for period of Six months only.
- 2. Envelop should be superscribed for "Quotation document for providing Stationery items to MERC, Mumbai" and must contain following:
 - a. Detailed list of Stationery items duly signed & sealed on each and every page.
 - Details of running Contract Orders atleast last 3 years for supply of Stationery items to Govt. Organization, Institutions or other reputed Firms/Companies recognized by the Govt.
 - c. Following Certificates of registration issued by Competent / Appropriate Authority need to be submitted :
 - (i) Certificate of Bombay Shop Act.
 - (ii) GSTN
 - (iii) PAN
 - (iv) Other statutory documents, if any.
 - d. Copies of IT returns Certified by C.A. countersigned by Supplier.
- 3. The firm/agency applying must have annual turnover of Rs. 20 lacs and above (Attach documentary proof).
- 4. The Supplier / Organization should send their offer on their letterhead to Deputy Director (Admin. & Fin.) in the office of Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission, 13thFloor, Centre-1, World Trade Centre, Cuffe Parade, Mumbai– 400 005 not later than 1700 hours on or before <u>30.01.2018</u> in the prescribed format.
- 5. The offer must be valid for a period of 90 days.
- 6. Price quoted by the Suppliers should be exclusive of GST.
- 7. The contract shall be for period of six months only. No price escalation shall be entertained during this contract period.
- 8. Payment shall be released against submission of bill & after checking of quantity/quality of receipt of material.
- 9. TDS under Section 194-C of Income Tax, if applicable, shall be deducted from the amount payable to you.
- 10. The office of the MERC reserves the right to reject the tender without assigning any reason.
