Daily Order

1. Heard the Advocates of the Petitioners and Respondents on 13 December, 2022.
2. Advocate of Respondent, MSETCL stated that it has received the copy of Petition on 6 December, 2022 as it was inadvertently submitted to other department of MSETCL. Therefore, MSETCL could not submit the reply to the Petitions and requested for adjournment of the hearings in the matter. Further, Advocate of MSETCL mentioned that MSETCL has also filed a Petition on 12 December, 2022 for clarification of Regulation 4.2 of MERC Supply Code Regulations, 2021 in regard to the laying of EHT network by Transmission Licensee. Advocate of MSEDCL consented adjournment request made by MSETCL
3. Advocate of the Petitioners stated that the present Petitions are filed seeking appropriate Orders to MSETCL as regards laying of EHT Lines and necessary infrastructure for supply of power at EHV Levels and seeking instant directions to MSEDCL for levying appropriate wheeling charges to the Petitioner as per Tariff Order dated 30 March, 2020 and the clarificatory Order dated 30 April, 2020 and pressed for early date for the further hearing, if the Commission accepts the adjournment request made by MSETCL.
4. Advocate for the Respondent MSEDCL submitted that the issue raised in the said petition is covered in the Tariff Order, Clarificatory Order and the Orders passed by the Commission in similar matters
5. The Commission directs MSETCL to file its replies to the Petitions within 1 week, covering all aspects of relevant cases finalized by this Commission, earlier and shall serve the copies of the same to all parties. Thereafter, rest of the parties may file their Rejoinders on the replies of MSETCL, if any within 3 days.
