- 1. The Advocate of the Petitioner summarized the background of the Petition in brief and requested the Commission to decide compensation for the Change in Law event as directed by the APTEL in remand Order. Addressing MSEDCL's objection, he stated that although MSEDCL has filed Civil Appeal against APTEL Judgment, Supreme Court have not stayed the APTEL Order and hence implementation of the same is binding as per the Law.
- 2. Advocate of MSEDCL pointed out that the Petitioner has not filed the documentary evidence in terms of claims raised in the Petition which are essential for deciding the compensation.
- 3. In view of that, the Commission directed the Petitioner to provide all the documentary evidence for justifying its claim and further directed both parties to sit together and reconcile the amount within one month. Submissions to be filed within a week thereafter.
