PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice inviting suggestions/objection on the Application filed by The Tata Power Company Limited for grant of Distribution Licence under Section 14 and Section 15 of Electricity Act, 2003 for Nashik, Sinnar, Igatpuri and Trimbak Talukas (Case No. 74 of 2025)

- The Tata Power Company Limited (Tata Power) has filed an Application (Case No. 74 of 2025) before the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (MERC/Commission) for grant of Distribution Licence to TPC for the geographically connected area comprising of Nashik, Sinnar, Igatpuri and Trimbak Talukas under Sections 14 and 15 of Electricity Act, 2003 ("the Act") read with provisions to MERC (General Conditions of Distribution License) Regulations, 2006 and other applicable Rules and Regulations. The Commission has admitted the Application on 19 June, 2025 and directed Tata Power to publish a Public Notice under Section 15 (2) of the Act

Summary of activities and past experience in similar activities:

granted a Distribution License to Tata Power (Distribution License No. 1 of 2014) for a period of 25 years for Mumbai City, and part of Mumbai Suburban Area, (areas of Mira Bhayandar Municipal Corporation including area covered under Chene and Vesave). Tata Power Distribution – Mumbai has a customer base of over 7.6 Lakh consumers in Mumbai across an area of 485 Sq. kms., with a network length of 4,850 ckt km and peak demand of around 1000 MW.

In the electricity distribution sector, Tata Power is providing uninterrupted, affordable, and reliable power supply to consumers across

Distribution License in Delhi: Tata Power Delhi Distribution Limited (Tata Power - DDL) was incorporated in July 2002 as a Joint Venture of the Tata Power Company Limited (51%) and the Government of the National Capital Territory of Delhi (49%) on the Public Private Partnership (PPP) model. Tata Power – DDL serves customer base of about 2 million, manages an electricity distribution network of about 12,500 ckt km. The AT&C loss levels have been reduced from 53.1% in 2002 to 5.9% in 2024.
- Distribution License in Central Odisha: Tata Power Central Odisha Distribution Limited (TPCODL) is a Joint Venture between Tata Power and the Government of Odisha with the majority stake being held by Tata Power Company (51%). TPCODL serves a customer base of 3.2 million over a vast distribution area of 29,354 sq. km. Starting from 30.49% at the time of acquisition in June 2020, the AT&C losses now stand at 18.94%. TPCODL manages an electricity distribution network of 98,033 ckt km.
- Distribution License in Northern Odisha: Tata Power Northern Odisha Distribution Limited (TPNODL) was formed in April 2021 as a Joint Venture between Tata Power (51%) and GRIDCO Ltd (49%) to carry out the function of distribution and retail supply of electricity. TPNODL serves customer base of 20.89 lakh, spanning across an area of 27920 sq. kms. The AT&C losses for the year stood at 11.15% at the end of FY 25 TPNODL manages and operates 564 power transformers, 77688 distribution transformers, 245 33/11KV substations, 3225.64 ckt km of 33KV lines, 41108.37 ckt km of 11KV lines and 68139.45 ckt km of LT lines.
- **Distribution License in Southern Odisha:** Tata Power Southern Odisha Distribution Limited (TPSODL) started its operations in January 2021. With a consumer base of about 2.20 million, TPSODL spans for around 48,751 Sq. kms. in the southern parts of Odisha. TPSODL manages and operates 4241ckt km of 33KV lines, 46985 ckt km of 11KV lines and 74617 ckt km of LT lines. The AT&C Loss of TPSODL stands at 19.63% for FY 25 Distribution License in Western Odisha: Tata Power Western Odisha Distribution Limited (TPWODL) is a Joint Venture between Tata Power (51%) and GRIDCO Limited (49%) and started its operations in January 2021. TPWODL had a registered customer base of 2.1 million covering 48,373 sq. km. TPWODL manages and operates 5632+ ckt km of 33KV lines, 51708+ ckt km of 11KV lines and 68557+
- ckt km of LT lines. The AT&C losses during FY 25 were 16.23%. Distribution Franchisee in Ajmer: Tata Power Ajmer Distribution Limited (TPADL) is a distribution franchisee having signed a Distribution Franchisee Agreement (DFA) with Ajmer Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited. TPADL is responsible for operating and maintaining the distribution network in Ajmer City and managing the billing and collection across an area of around 200 Sq. Kms. TPADL has contributed towards reduction of AT&C losses from 17.2% to 8.22%.
