The Case No. 18 of 2012, filed by Tata Motors Limited is admitted. The Petitioner, Tata Motors Ltd, has served a copy of its Petition, in the hearing, along with the Interim Application. It has been received by the Representative of the Respondent.

The Respondent has not yet filed its written say, on affidavit, in Case No. 8 of 2012, inspite being served way back on November 28, 2011.
