Heard the representatives of the Petitioner and the advocates and representatives of the Respondent No. 2.

The Respondent No. 2 is directed to obtain complete blockwise generation data of Wardha Power, required for detailed analysis, as the same has not been provided, .

The Petitioner and Respondent No. 2 are directed to independently study the available data which has been submitted by the private sector generating companies M/s JSW, Abhijit and Wardha Power, and subsequently interact and discuss with each other to detect any specific instances of incorrect backing down instructions issue by MSLDC, as alleged by the Petitioner.

Respondent No. 2 is directed to take up with RLDC, the matter regarding vesting the responsibility on MSLDC regarding scheduling the Power generation by RGPPL, rather than the present practice of scheduling by RLDC, as 95% of the power generated by RGPPL is disbursed in Maharashtra State.

Respondent No. 2 is further directed to fine tune the draft SoPs, prepared for implementation of MOD, so as to make the same suitable for use as ready-reference documents for line operations.

The Commission's office is directed to forthwith issue enquiry to CPRI for carrying out certification work of the "Technical Minimum" of Thermal Power plants.

Post the matter for further hearing on Wednesday, 3rd April 2012, at 11.00 hrs.
