Heard the Advocates and Representatives of the Petitioners and Respondents. The Commission clarifies that Cross Subsidy Surcharge (CSS) at only 25% of the applicable CSS is payable by Open

Access Consumers purchasing power from renewable sources of energy, as laid down in Order dated 9 September, 2011 in Case No. 43 of 2010.

Respondent No.1 is free to file a separate Petition, if it requires any changes in CSS applicable to Open Access Consumers purchasing power from renewable sources of energy. Till then Open Access Consumers purchasing power from renewable sources of energy need to pay CSS only 25% of the applicable CSS.
