#### **Daily Order**

- 1. Heard the Petitioner, the Respondent and the Authorised Consumer Representatives.
- 2. The Commission noted that the issues raised in the present Petition (i.e., request for allowing impact on Tariff due to coal shortage as per the advice issued by Ministry of Power through their letter dated 31 July, 2013) may affect multiple cases. Therefore, there is a need to deliberate the issue among all stakeholders including Authorised Consumer Representatives.
- 3. The Commission directs the Petitioner to submit their assessment of impact due to the present coal shortage on the PPA Tariff; and also project future scenarios. The Petitioner is further directed to bring out issues for developing a comprehensive solution.
- 4. The Commission directs the Respondent, MSEDCL to submit its stand on the above advice issued by Ministry of Power and specific issues raised by the Petitioner.
- 5. The Commission further directs the Petitioner to implead Government of Maharashtra (Energy Department) as a party in this matter and serve a copy of the Petition on them. Govt. Of Maharashtra is required to submit its stand on above said advice of MoP.

- 6. The Commission also directs Authorised Consumer Representatives to make their submission on above said advice issued by MoP.
- 7. All above submission needs to be made on or before 5 December, 2013 with copy served on all the parties.
- 8. After receiving the submissions from all the parties, Secretariat of the Commission will communicate the next date of hearing in this matter.
