MSEDCL is directed to submit a detailed representation on affidavit substantiating its submission that power scenario in State of Maharashtra has changed since 2004 till date, with facts and figures.

MSEDCL is directed to submit the year-wise details (upto current situation) of demand-supply

scenario as compared to the demand-supply considered in the Order dated 8 September, 2004 in

Case Nos. 55 and 56 of 2003 in the State of Maharashtra. Further, MSEDCL is also directed to

submit the year-wise details of demand-supply w.r.t., peak load deficit/surplus in percentage

terms.

MSEDCL is also directed to submit the impact of providing the banking facility to the Petitioner

and also the consequent impact of providing banking facility to similar fossil fuel based captive

power plant and open access consumers.

The Commission expressed its displeasure on not receiving response from Government of

Maharashtra on its letter dated 15 October, 2013 seeking the status of advice on the issues

stipulated in the Order dated 8 September, 2004 in Case Nos. 55 and 56 of 2003 and directed the
