The Commission inquired with MSEDCL about the procedure for Open Access transaction

MSEDCL submitted that the Open Access in such cases has been granted only prospectively

and not retrospectively. Since the Petitioner had applied for Open Access vide letter dated 21

May, 2014, the permission was granted from 1 June, 2014 to 31 March, 2015. MSEDCL

further submitted that generally the consumer submits application for Open Access prior to

the effective month of Open Access issuance.
