In the matter of:- Petition of MSEDCL under Sections 42 (2) & 86 (1) of the Electricity Act, 2003 & Regulation 13 of MERC (Distribution Open Access) Regulations, 2005 for seeking re-determination of Cross Subsidy Surcharge.

Daily Order

Heard the Advocate and Representative of the Petitioner.

MSEDCL reiterated the submissions made in the Petition and requested to grant following relief:

- a. Subsequent to MERC's Order dated 26 June, 2015 in Case No. 95 of 2013 confirming AEC-1 and AEC-2, declare that CSS determined to reflect AEC-1 and AEC-2 in Order dated 29 October, 2013 in Case No. 107 of 2013 was correct.
- b. Re-determine the CSS calculated in Case No. 107 of 2013 for considering additional impact of AEC-3, AEC-4 and additional FAC.

Further, MSEDCL submitted that one consumer has approached it for refund of CSS as per ATE's Order dated 11 September, 2013 wherein MERC's Order in Case No. 107 of 2013 has been remanded. However, MSEDCL is yet to refund such CSS as present matter is subjudice before this Commission.

The Commission observed that the period under consideration is part of FY 2013-14. True up of expenses and revenue for FY 2013-14 has been completed in Case No. 121 of 2014 Order dated 26 June, 2015. Hence, the Commission directed MSEDCL to file its submission on following:

- a. Whether over/under recovery of CSS for FY 2013-14 has not been factored in True up and financial implications of the same on MSEDCL, if any.
- b. Procedure to be followed for redetermination of CSS, if any

Above submissions need to be filed within two weeks.

Next date of hearing will be communicated by the Secretariat of the Commission.
