### **Daily Order**

Heard the Representatives of the Petitioner and Authorised Consumer Representative.

The Petitioner reiterated the following two issues of the Petition seeking review of the Commission's Order dated 20 April, 2015 in Case No. 201 of 2014:

- 1. Disallowance of actual equity deployment while approving the debt equity ratio for Bhusawal Units 4 and 5;
- 2. Recovery of Energy Charges while carrying out Provisional True up of FY 2014-15.

Authorised Consumer Representative, Dr. Ashok Pendse on behalf of TBIA submitted that, if the actual equity is considered by the Commission, then the same treatment should be given to the undischarged liability.

The Commission inquired about the debt-equity ratio of the Petitioner's recently commissioned new Units, to which the Petitioner submitted a debt equity ratio of 80:20 approximately. The Commission directs MSPGCL to submit its comments on para 4.7.6 of the Commission's Order dated 20 April, 2015 in Case No. 201 of 2014 by 30 November, 2015.
