The Petitioner reiterated its submission on the following issues of the Petition seeking review of the Commission's Order dated 26 June, 2015 in Case No. 15 of 2015:-

- 1. Non-Consideration of relaxed Availability and Auxiliary consumption norms for Stations which experienced abnormal rainfall.
- 2. Non-Consideration of Normative O&M expenses approved in MYT Order for FY 2013-14
- 3. Discrepancy in reversal of prior period item in FY 2013-14
- 4. Disallowance of Capitalisation for Paras Units 3&4 and Khaperkheda Unit 5
- 5. Excess recovery done in reference to MYT Tariff Order for FY 2013-14
- 6. Issues in O&M Expenses allowed for FY 2014-15 and FY 2015-16
- 7. Issues in AFC disallowance in FY 2015-16
- 8. Extension of economic shutdown of Units till the issuance of the Order in Case No 15 of 2015

Authorised Consumer Representative, Dr. Ashok Pendse on behalf of TBIA referred to the water shortage situation at Parli TPS and stated that he is in consonance with the Commission's approach towards the disallowance of AFC as it is in Consumer's interest.
