Heard the Representative of the Petitioner and Advocate of the Respondent.

The Petitioner acknowledged the receipt of Rs. 1, 42,000/- towards compensation from the Respondent MEGPTCL at the time of erection of towers and after completion of work in instalments. Petitioner contended that the compensation paid by the Respondent is less and

not certified by the Revenue Authority. Hence, the Petitioner requested to direct the District Collector, Buldhana to determine the compensation amount.

The Advocate for Respondent mentioned that he has not received the copy of Petition and asked for three weeks time for filing the reply, which is granted by the Commission.

The Commission directs the Respondent to file a comprehensive Reply including basis of the payment of compensation with relevant documents, and serve a copy to the Petitioner.

On request of the Petitioner, the Commission granted one week time to file the Rejoinder thereafter.
