Heard the Representatives of the Petitioner.

Advocate for IEPL stated that the Commission, during the TVS held on 6 September, 2016, had observed that the question of cost recovery does not arise in absence of PPA with a Distribution Licensee. In spite of its best efforts, IEPL could not execute a firm long term PPA with any Distribution Licensee. In view of above, the Commission is requested to keep the Petition in abeyance till IEPL executes a long term PPA and a beneficiary is identified for its Generation Plant.

To a query of the Commission, IEPL stated that a period of one year may be required for this purpose and for execution of a PPA.

The Commission observed that, apart from the absence of PPA, there are other issues (recorded in the TVS minutes) which are relevant to the outcome of the Petition and that, instead of asking for the Petition in abeyance for so long, IEPL may withdraw its Petition with liberty to approach the Commission afresh.

IEPL sought four weeks for making its submission on this, which the Commission allowed.

Next date of hearing, if at all required post IEPL's submission, shall be communicated by the Secretariat of the Commission.
