**Petition of M/s. Tulshi Casting and Machining Ltd. under Section 142 of Electricity Act, 2003 against MSEDCL for non-compliance of the Electricity Ombudsman, Mumbai's Order dated 06.01.2017 in Representation No. 161 of 2016.**

**Daily Order**

Heard the Representative of the Petitioner.

1. Representative of the Petitioner stated as follows :

- a) He re-iterated the submissions as stated in the Petition. He stated that the Electricity Ombudsman (EO), Mumbai in his Order dated 6 January, 2017 while accepting the proposal of the Petitioner to furnish an Indemnity Bond, directed MSEDCL to refund the security deposit within a period of one-month after receiving the Indemnity Bond. Subsequently, as per the EO's Order, it was furnished on 20 January, 2017.
- b) Vide its letter dated 12 May, 2017, MSEDCL had informed the deficiency of not furnishing Pan Card / Aadhar Card of the Directors/ Chairman in the Indemnity Bond, which Petitioner furnished on 22 May, 2017.
- c) MSEDCL had also informed that approval for refund of security deposit is sought from its Corporate Office and that, after the funds were made available, it would refund the security deposit.

- d) Instead of complying with the EO's Order, MSEDCL filed a Review Application which was rejected by the EO on 21 April, 2017. Thereafter, it was expected that MSEDCL would comply with the EO's Order. However, the compliance is still awaited.
2. Representative of MSEDCL was not present during the hearing, but arrived after the proceedings were over. However, MSEDCL had submitted its Reply on 29 May, 2017.
  3. Representative of the Petitioner requested the Commission to issue a Show Cause Notice under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 to MSEDCL for non-compliance of the EO's Order.
