The Commission asked SWPGL whether the Special Energy Meters (SEM) installed at each of its Generating Units are with 15 minutes time integration feature and in operation mode for the purpose of MD and kWh both, and whether the current SEMs are recording MD and kWh on 15 minutes time integration. The Advocate of SWPGL stated that he would collect the information and file a submission accordingly.

The Commission also directed SWPGL to implead Maharashtra State Load Despatch Centre (MSLDC) and State Transmission Utility (STU), and to serve them immediately.

SWPGL may file its additional submission within two weeks, and MSEDCL may file its response within a week thereafter.

MSLDC and STU are also directed to file their say upon receipt of the Petition.

The Commission also directs MSEDCL to depute an Executive Director - level Officer dealing with the matter at the next hearing.

The Secretariat of the Commission will communicate the next date of hearing.
