#### **Daily Order**

Advocates of Petitioner and Respondent in Case No. 26 of 2019 appeared before the Commission as per the Hon'ble ATE Judgment dated 20 September 2021.

Advocate appearing for MSEDCL informed that it has preferred an Appeal before Hon'ble Supreme Court against the ATE Judgment dated 20 September 2021.

Advocate of RM submitted that till today no stay order has been issued on the preferred appeal. Therefore, the Commission may direct the parties to file their submission on affidavit.

The Commission noted that in Para 43 of the Judgment dated 20 September 2021, ATE has directed to ensure that MSEDCL shall discharge its liability within three months. Hence, the Commission directs, RM to file its submission on quantification of claim in terms of ATE's directives within 15 days and MSEDCL may respond to the RM's statement within 15 days thereafter. RM may file Rejoinder, if any, within 10 days thereafter.

After the receipt of submissions from Parties as above, the Secretariat of the Commission will communicate next date of hearing so as to comply the ATE Order within the stipulated time frame.
