- (d) quash the invoices raised by the Respondent No. 1 (as mentioned in paragraph 10 of the present application), containing imposition of CSS ,for the power sourced by the Petitioner to its captive user for the month of February 2013, and further direct the Respondent No. 1 to issue fresh invoices/bills without the levy of CSS
- (e) pass such other and further orders as this Hon'ble Commission deems fit and proper under the facts and circumstances of the present case.
