

NOTICE

Subject: Petition of Energy Department, Government of Maharashtra for Implementation of rationalised tariff for residential consumers of MSEDCL, Rinfra-D, and BEST consuming 0-300 units per month.

- **Case No. 54 of 2014**

Energy Department, Government of Maharashtra has submitted a Petition under affidavit on 26.02.2014, under Section 86(1) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and Article 38 of Constitution of India, 1950 and Regulation 100 of the MERC(MYT), Regulation 2011 for implementation of rationalised tariff for residential consumers of MSEDCL, Rinfra-D, and BEST consuming 0-300 units per month.

The main prayers of the Petitioner are as under-

“1) Admit this Petition in accordance with Section 86 (1) and 94 of the Electricity Act 2003 and Regulation 100 of the MERC (MYT Regulations) 2011.

2) Allow the R-Infra and BEST to charge the Energy Charge of Rs. 3.50 per unit to the residential consumers consuming 0-100 Units per month and allow BEST to charge energy charge of Rs. 6.05 per unit to the residential consumers consuming 101-300 Units per month.

3) To allow the recovery of the differential amount due to proposed tariff from other consumers or defer the same.

4) Pass such further and other orders, as the Hon'ble Commission may deem fit and proper keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case.

5) Condone any error / omission and to give opportunity to rectify the same.

6) permit the Petitioner to make further submissions, addition and alteration to this Petition as may be necessary from time to time.”

2. am directed to communicate that the hearing in the above matter will be held in the presence of the authorized consumer representatives on **Thursday, 08 May, 2014 at 12.00 hrs** in the office of the Commission at 13th floor, Centre No.1, World Trade Centre, Cuffe Parade, Mumbai 400 005

3. The Petitioner is directed to immediately serve a copy of its above mentioned Petition, along with its accompaniments, (both in soft and hard versions) to the Respondent and the authorized consumer representatives.

4. The Respondent is directed to submit its say, if any, on affidavit, on the above mentioned Petition with a copy served to the Petitioner and the consumer representatives.
