Subject: - Petition of M/s. Lloyds Metals & Energy Limited for Addendum Petition with revised prayers to the Petition filed in Case No. 56 of 2011, under Section 62 (1) (a) and 86 (1) (e) of the Electricity Act 2003 for determination of tariff for supply of electricity from Industrial waste heat recovery co-generation Power plant of 30 MW capacity at Ghugus, Dist Chandrapur of Maharashtra to the Distribution licensee in Maharashtra and fixation of purchase obligation for electricity produced from waste heat recovery based Co-generation plants.

- **Case No. 220 of 2014**

M/s. Lloyds Metals & Energy Ltd. has submitted a Petition under affidavit on 09.12.2014, under Sections 62 (1) (a) and 86 (1) (e) of the Electricity Act, 2003 for determination of tariff for supply of electricity from Industrial waste heat recovery co-generation Power plant of 30 MW capacity at Ghugus, Dist Chandrapur of Maharashtra to the Distribution licensee in Maharashtra and fixation of purchase obligation for electricity produced from waste heat recovery based Co-generation plants.

The main prayers of the Petitioner are as under-

- “1) Cross subsidy surcharge (CSS) as 25% of the applicable CSS for open access consumer purchasing power from Co – generation source of energy.*
- 2) Wheeling Charge as 25% of the applicable Wheeling Charge for open access consumer purchasing power from Co – generation source of energy.*
- 3) Other Open Access Charges equivalent to applicable to renewable sources of energy.”*

The Revised prayers of the Petitioner are as under-

The petitioner M/s Lloyds Metal & Energy Ltd humbly requests the Hon’ble Commission to and accept the revised prayers in Case 56 of 2011, as uner:

*“A) Accept this Addendum Petition for:*

- a) Fixing Cross subsidy surcharge (CSS) as 25% of the applicable CSS for open access consumer purchasing power from Co – generation source of energy.*
- b) Fixing Wheeling Charge as 25% of the applicable Wheeling Charge for open access consumer purchasing power from Co – generation source of energy.*
- c) Fixing other Open Access Charge equivalent to applicable to renewable sources of energy.”*

*B) To grant an opportunity in person before Hon Commission during the hearing on the above Matter.*

*C) Condone any inadvertent omission / errors / short comings and permit the petitioner to add / change / modify / alter this filling and make future submission as may be required at a future date.*

I am directed to communicate that the hearing in the above matter will be held in the presence of the authorized consumer representatives on **Tuesday, 03 February, 2015 at 11.30 hrs** in the office of the Commission at 13<sup>th</sup> Floor, Centre No.1, World Trade Centre, Cuffe Parade, Mumbai - 400 005.

4. The Petitioner is directed to immediately serve a copy of its above mentioned Petition (both in soft and hard versions) to the Respondent and the authorised consumer representatives before the scheduled date of hearing.

5. The Respondent is directed to submit its say on affidavit, if any, on the above mentioned Petition with a copy to the Petitioner and the authorised consumer representatives well in advance.
