- d) To pass any other order(s), as the Hon'ble Commission may deem fit and appropriate under the circumstances of the present case and in the interest of justice;
- *e) Allow additions / alterations / changes / modifications to the petition if required;*
- f) Condone any inadvertent omissions / errors / rounding off / differences / shortcomings."
