

NOTICE

Subject: Petition of Sun N Sand Hotels Private Limited for seeking relief under clauses 21(Power to remove difficulties), 22 (Savings) of the Distribution Open Access Regulations 2005 and 44.4 of the Distribution Open Access Regulations 2014 the relevant rulings / clauses of Electricity Act, 2003 (with amendments).

- **Case No. 197 of 2014**

Sun N Sand Hotels Private Limited (Sun N Sand) has submitted a Petition under affidavit on 05.11.2014 under Regulation 21& 22 of the MERC (Distribution Open Access) Regulations 2005 & 44.4 of the MERC (Distribution Open Access) Regulations 2014 for seeking directions / orders relating to Open Access, scheduling charges & Generation credit notes.

The main prayers of the Petitioner are as under -

“Therefore, the petitioner seeks the Hon. Commission’s ruling / directions for the purpose of removing difficulties under Distribution Open Access Regulations 2005 for the following relief’s to the petitioner

1) By directing Respondent 2 (MSEDCL) to issue open access permissions as requested in our applications from April 2014 to March 2015.

2) By directing the respondent 2 to issue credit reports from 01.04.2014 and directing RIL & MSLDC to give credits for all the generated units in our energy bills.

3) To direct that SLDC should not levy the scheduling charges for renewable energy open access transactions for all intra state open access

4) To direct MSLDC and Respondent 1(RIL) to give effect the open access credit within one month from the date of issue of “Generation Credit Note” by MSEDCL. Further, by directing the utilities to pay interest at commercial rate for the delayed credits of the wheeled energy.

Having submitted the above, the Petitioner now Pray before the Hon. Commission without prejudice:

a) By directing Respondent 2 (MSEDCL) to issue open access permissions as requested in our applications from April 2014 to March 2015.

b) By directing the respondent 2 to issue credit reports from 01.04.2014 and directing RIL & MSLDC to give timely credits for all the generated units in our energy bills. To direct that SLDC should not levy the scheduling charges for renewable energy open access transactions for all intra state open access.

c) By directing MSLDC and Respondent 1(RIL) to give effect the open access credit within one month from the date of issue of "Generation Credit Note" by MSEDCL. Further, by directing the utilities to pay interest at commercial rate for the delayed credits of the wheeled energy.

d) To pass suitable orders to respondents to issue open access permission and the credit reports for the generation of power from 1st April 2014.

e) To pass any suitable orders to give relief to us as we are financially affected party.

f) To permit us to amend / modify / add / delete any of the points during the course of hearing if needed. "

3. I am directed to communicate that the hearing in the above matter will be held in the presence of the authorized consumer representatives on **Tuesday, 12 May, 2015 at 11.30 hrs** in the office of the Commission at 13th floor, Centre No.1, World Trade Centre, Cuffe Parade, Mumbai - 400 005.

4. The Petitioner is directed to immediately serve a copy of its above mentioned Petition (both in soft and hard versions) to the Respondent and the authorised consumer representatives before the scheduled date of hearing.

5. The Respondent is directed to submit its say on affidavit, if any, on the above mentioned Petition with a copy to the Petitioner and the authorised consumer representatives well in advance.
