- (d) In furtherance of prayer (b) and (c) above, re-determine the O&M Expenses allowed to the Petitioner for the third Control Period under the order dated October 21, 2016 passed in Case No. 47 of 2016 after suitably correcting the distortion in O&M Expenses for the second Control Period;
- (e) Pass such other order(s) as this Hon'ble Commission may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
