Under the provisions of its Renewable Purchase Obligation, its compliance and Implementation

of Renewable Energy Certificate Framework Regulations, 2010, the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission is verifying the compliance of Renewable Purchase Obligation (RPO) targets by Captive Power Plant (CPP) Users and Open Access (OA) Consumers in Maharashtra for FY 2010-11 to FY 2013-14 in Case No. 101 of 2017

The Commission has issued notices to 680 CPP Users and OA Consumers, based on the data provided by the
