- This is with reference to your Petition for Truing up of Budget Cost of Operation for FY 2015-16 & 2016-17, Provisional truing-up for FY 2017-18 and ARR forecast and determination of Fees and Charges for FY 2018-19 to FY 2019-20, replies to the data gaps raised before and during the discussion held on 12 December, 2017 and revised Petition submitted on 4 January, 2018.

- MSLDC shall host the Executive Summary of its Petition (both in English and Marathi) and the Petition submitted to the Commission on its website besides hosting formats in MS Excel for easy download by any person. MSLDC shall make available a hard copy of the Petition to any person with all Annexures (or CD of detailed Petition with all Annexures), on written request, at the rates specified in the approved Public Notice enclosed with this letter. MSLDC shall ensure that the copies of the Annexures are legible.
- MSLDC shall make available copies of the Executive Summary of its Petition (both in English and Marathi version) at its offices specified in the approved Public Notice, free of cost.
- All the above Petition documents shall be made available by MSLDC in the specified form at the specified offices, latest by 8 January, 2018.

 - c. Replies to Data Gaps raised, with relevant Annexures

Inviting Suggestions/Objections on Maharashtra State Load Despatch Centre's Petition for Truing up of FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17, Provisional Truing-up of FY 2017-18, and revised estimates for Aggregate Revenue Requirement and Determination of Fees and Charges for FY 2018-19 and FY 2019-20

 Maharashtra State Load Despatch Centre (MSLDC) has filed a Petition for Truing up of Budget Cost of Operations for FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17, Provisional Truing-up of FY 2017-18, revised estimates of Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) and determination of Fees and Charges for FY 2018-19 and FY 2019-20 in accordance with MERC (Multi Year Tariff) Regulations ('MYT Regulations'),2015.

The filing for the Truing-up of FY 2015-16 is based on the MYT Regulations,2011, previous Orders of the Commission on MSLDC's Operating and Capital Charges and Regulation 18.9 of the MERC (Transmission Open Access) Regulations, 2014. Filing for Truing up of FY 2016-17, Provisional Truing up of FY 2017-18 and revised estimates of ARR and Determination of Fees and Charges for FY 2018-19 and FY 2019-20 is based on the MYT Regulations, 2015 and other relevant Regulations.

- 2. The Commission has admitted the Petition on **5 January**, **2018** and directed MSLDC to publish a Public Notice under Section 64(2) of the Electricity Act, 2003 inviting suggestions/objections.
