Subject: Petition of RattanIndia Power Limited under Section 86 of the Electricity Act, 2003 seeking compensation for penalty imposed by SECL on account of non-procurement of minimum quantity of fuel by RattanIndia under the FSA, due to low despatch by MSEDCL in accordance with Clause 4.5 of Schedule 4 of the PPA between RattanIndia and MSEDCL.

- **Case No. 146 of 2018**

RattanIndia Power Limited has submitted a Petition on 11.05.2018 under Section 86 of the Electricity Act, 2003 seeking compensation for penalty imposed by SECL on account of non-procurement of minimum quantity of fuel by RattanIndia under the FSA, due to low despatch by MSEDCL in accordance with Clause 4.5 of Schedule 4 of the PPA between RattanIndia and MSEDCL.

The main prayers of the Petitioner are as under-

(a) *Direct MSEDCL to release the amount of Rs.39,76,78,719.63/- along with interest / carrying cost in favour of RattanIndia; and*

(b) *Pass any such other and further reliefs as this Hon'ble Commission deems just and proper in the nature and circumstances of the present case.*

4. The Respondent is directed to submit the say immediately on affidavit in 1+6 copies to the Commission with documents, if any, on the above mentioned Petition, with a copy to the Petitioner and authorized Consumer Representatives, the CRs may submit there say before hearing.

5. The Parties are directed to file their Petition and submissions in MS -Word file and PDF version as far as possible and to file 1+6 copies of all relevant documents/citations produced during the proceedings.
