- c. Direct MSEDCL to make payment of the outstanding amount towards DPC as per the WEPA due till date within seven (7) days [a sum of Rs. 68,03,597.00 (Rupees Sixty Eight Lakhs Three Thousand Five Hundred and Ninety Seven Only) is due as on June 30, 2018 as detailed in Annex D];
- d. Direct Respondent to issue credit notes within fifteen (15) days generation and comply with the Citizen Charter to enable the Petitioner to issue invoices under the WEPA in a timely manner;
- e. Direct the Respondent to pay carrying cost at the rate of 15% per annum of the delay in payment of the late/delayed payment surcharge by the Respondent;
- f. Award costs of these proceedings against MSEDCL and in favour of the Petitioner; and
- g. Pass such other order(s) as the Hon'ble Commission may deem just in the facts of the present case."
