- b) Without prejudice and in the alternative to prayer clause a) above, modify, if necessary, the MYT Order dated 28.10.2016 to the extent it does not provide for a refund of TDLR Charges in the amounts of Rs. 18,88,72,618/- paid by the Petitioner to the Respondent in respect of the Electricity Connections, including an amount of Rs. 14,87,65,896/- paid in respect of the electricity connection bearing Consumer No. 101-538-000*0; and
- (c) Pass such other relief as Hon'ble Commission deems fit and appropriate under the circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice.
