## PUBLIC NOTICE

Objections / comments on Tata Power-Distribution Business' (Tata Power-D) Petition for determination of Wheeling Charges for EHV consumers as per ATE Judgment dated 18 March, 2019.  
(Case No. 95 of 2019)

- The Appellate Tribunal for Electricity (ATE) vide its Judgment dated 18 March, 2019 in Appeal No. 84 of 2018 has directed the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission to determine Wheeling Charges for consumer connected on Extra High Voltage (EHV) level.
- Accordingly, THE TATA POWER COMPANY LIMITED's Distribution Business (Tata Power-D) has filed the Petition in Case No. 95 of 2019 before the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (MERC) for determination of Wheeling Charges for EHV consumers. The Commission has admitted the Petition on 9 May, 2019 and directed Tata Power-D to publish a Public Notice under Section 64(2) of the Act.
- Tata Power-D in its Petition has proposed following approach for determining Wheeling Charges:

### Proposed Approach

In the MTR Order in Case No. 69 of 2018, the wheeling charges were determined excluding EHV sales basis the understanding that EHV consumers are connected to transmission. As per the ATE judgment in Appeal 84 of 2018, it has been established that EHV consumers can be and are connected to distribution system of Tata Power-D and accordingly wheeling charges are applicable to EHV consumers. Based on this judgment, the wheeling charges have been determined by adopting the principles laid down in the MYT Order dated 21st October, 2016 after including EHV sales. The existing wheeling charges and the proposed wheeling charges are shown in the Table below:

- Every person who intends to file objections/comments can submit the same in English or in Marathi, in six copies, and should carry the full name, postal address and e-mail address, if any, of the sender. It should be indicated whether the objection/comment is being filed on behalf of any organization of category of consumers. It should also be mentioned if the sender wants to be heard in person, in which case opportunity would be given by the Commission at the Public Hearing to be held **Monday, 10 June, 2019 at 10.00 AM in the Office of the Commission at the 13th Floor, Centre No.1, World Trade Centre, Cuffe Parade, Mumbai-400005.** for which no separate notice will be given.

- Tata Power-D shall reply to each of the objections /comments received within three days of the receipt of the same but not later than 6 June 2019 for all the objections/comments received till 3 June, 2019. Stakeholders can submit their rejoinders on replies provided by TPC-D either during the public hearing or latest by 13 June, 2019.
