Subject:- Petition filed by SEP Energy Private Limited under Section 42 (2), 61 (b), 61 (c), 61 (d), 61 (f), 61 (h), 66, 86 (1) (e), 86 (3) of the Electricity Act 2003 to take suitable steps for the protection of Small Wind Energy Generators by providing for a suitable banking mechanism.

- **Case No. 229 of 2019**

The Petitioner SEP Energy Private Limited filed this Petition on 09.08.2019 under Section 42 (2), 61 (b), 61 (c), 61 (d), 61 (f), 61 (h), 66, 86 (1) (e), 86 (3) of the Electricity Act 2003 to take suitable steps for the protection of Small Wind Energy Generators by providing for a suitable banking mechanism.

(a) *To take suitable steps for the protection of small wind energy generators by providing for a suitable banking mechanism in light of the issues raised in the present petition; and/or*
