

**NOTICE**

Subject:- Petition of MSPL Limited under Regulation 19 of the MERC (forecasting, scheduling and deviation settlement for solar and wind generation) Regulations 2018 for removal of difficulties in giving effect to the provisions of the Regulations and implementation thereof.

- **Case No. 256 of 2019**

The Petitioner MSPL Limited has filed the Petition on 23.09.2019 under Regulation 19 of the MERC (forecasting, scheduling and deviation settlement for solar and wind generation) Regulations 2018 for removal of difficulties in giving effect to the provisions of the Regulations and implementation thereof.

The main prayers of the Petitioner are as under-

(a) *That this Hon'ble Commission may pleased to admit the Petition for removing practical difficulties faced by the Petitioner in implementation of F & S Regulations as provided under the provisions of Regulation 19 of the F & S Regulations.*

(b) *To provide a trial/grace period of twelve (12) months w.e.f. July 01, 2019 to assess the challenges faced in compliance with the provisions of F & S Regulations relating to scheduling and forecasting and penalty be levied for any deviation thereafter instead of penalty being imposed for any deviation from the date of coming effect of F & S Regulations 8 i.e. July 01, 2019.*

(c) *To direct formation of committee to study in detail the impact of F & S Regulations, whether such forecasting can be accurately done to attain the objective of the F & S Regulations for effective implementation thereof.*

2. I am directed to communicate that the hearing in the above matter will be held on **Tuesday, 01 October, 2019 at 10.00 hrs** in the office of the Commission at 13<sup>th</sup> floor, Centre No.1, World Trade Centre, Cuffe Parade, Mumbai - 400 005.

3. The Petitioner is directed to immediately serve a copy of its above mentioned Petition (both in soft and hard Copy) to the Respondents before the scheduled date of hearing.

4. The Respondents are directed to submit the say on affidavit in 1+6 copies to the Commission with documents, if any, on the above mentioned Petition immediately, with a copy to the Petitioner.

5. The Parties are directed to file their Petition and submissions in MS -Word file and PDF version as far as possible and to file 1+6 copies of all relevant documents/citations produced during the proceedings.
