The Petitioner Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Co. Ltd has filed this Petition on 13.05.2020 under Regulation 94 and 96 of MERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2004 seeking immediate recovery of pending claims of MSEDCL along with carrying cost under MERC approved FBSM in respect of variable charges and fixed charges on account of over drawl by Mumbai utilities during FY 2018-19 & 2019-20 and differential amount towards variable charges on account of revision in WASMP rate during the period 2011-12 to 2017-18 and fixed charges as per MERC order dated 26.09.2019.

MSEDCL has filed Miscellaneous Application on 22 .5.2020 for Interim Relief

The main prayers of the Petitioner are as under-

- a) To admit the Petition as per the provisions of Electricity Act 2003 and Regulation mentioned in the petition.
- b) To allow immediate recovery of the estimated amount of Rs.1445.35 Cr towards provisional settlement of FBSM bills from Mumbai utilities in view of the delayed settlement of FBSM bills by MSLDC.
- *c)* To issue immediate directives to MSLDC accordingly to raise bill of Rs. 1445.35 Cr to Mumbai Utilities corresponding to the estimated amount.
- *d)* To allow carrying cost on the pending claims at applicable interest rate for the delay period as mentioned in para23 above.
- *e)* To pass any other order/relief as the Hon'ble Commission may deem fit and appropriate under the circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice;
- *f)* To condone any error/omission and to give opportunity to rectify the same;

The main prayers of Miscellaneous Application Interim Relief are asunder:

a. To allow immediate and urgent listing of M.A though "Video Conference Facility" in view of COVID-19 as well as the Practice Direction dated 11.05.2020 issued by the Hon'ble Commission;

b. Ad-Interim reliefs, in the form of directions to SLDC to raise provisional bills of amounts as claimed to the tune of Rs. 1445.35 Cr towards variable charges and fixed charges for FY 2018-2019 and FY 2019-2020 on account of over drawl by Mumbai Utilities and recomputation of the WASMP for the period from FY 2011-12 to FY 2017-18 alongwith Carrying Cost

c. Directions to the Mumbai Utilities to make immediate payments of the provisional bills raised by SLDC ;

d. Direct MSLDC to immediately comply with the Order dated 26.09.2019 passed in Case No. 297 of 2018 w.r.t raising of "Supplementary Bills", alongwith Carrying Cost;

e. Pass such further orders as this Hon'ble Commission deems fit and proper in the interest of justice and good conscience.
