Subject: Petition filed by Adani Electricity Mumbai Limited seeking review of the Multi Year Tariff Order issued on 30.03.2020 by the Hon'ble Commission in Case No. 326 of 2019.

The Petitioner Adani Electricity Mumbai Limited has filed this Petition on 04.6.2020 under Section 94 (1) (f) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Regulation 85 of Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2004 framed under Section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Order 47 Rule 1 of the CPC, 1908 seeking review of the order dated 30.03.2020 passed by the Hon'ble Commission in Case No.326 of 2019 filed by M/s. Tata Power Company Distribution Business (TPC-D) for Multi Year Tariff (MYT) Petition for the Fourth Control Period including Truing up of ARR for FY 17-18 and FY 18-19, provisional Truing up of FY 19-20 and approval of ARR and tariff from FY 20-21 to FY 24-25;

- d. *That this Hon'ble Commission may be pleased to approve mechanism for pass through of the additional cost in the tariffs of TPC-D for FY 20-21;*
- e. *Pass any Order(s) as this Hon'ble Commission may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the present case.”*
