Subject: Petition of Adani Power Maharashtra Limited (APML) for compensation in tariff on account of “Change in Law” under the PPAs dated 31.03.2010, 19.08.2010 and 16.02.2013.

Application filed by APML on 10.10.2020 to issue the consequential order in view of Appellate Tribunal for Electricity Judgment on 14 September, 2020 in Appeal No. 182 of 2019. - MA No. 53 of 2020

**Case No. 189 of 2013 and 140 of 2014 and MA No. 53 of 2020**

The Appellate Tribunal for Electricity has passed the Judgment on 14 September, 2020 in Appeal No. 182 of 2019 against MERC Order dated 7 March, 2018 in Case No. 189 of 2013 and 140 of 2014 and has directed as under:-

*“For the foregoing reasons, we are of the considered view that the issues raised in the instant Appeal No. 182 of 2019 have merits and hence, appeal is allowed.*

*The impugned order dated 07.03.2018 passed by Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission in Case Nos. 189 of 2013 and 140 of 2014 are hereby set aside to the extent challenged in the Appeal and our findings, stated supra.*

*The State Commission is directed to issue the consequential orders as expeditiously as possible within a period of three months from the pronouncement of this judgment / order.”*
