Subject: Petition of WinIndia Ventures Pvt Ltd. against Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company Limited (MSEDCL) for non-compliance of common order dated 03.07.2020 in case no. 24 of 2020.

Case No. 179 of 2020

The Hon'ble Appellate Tribunal for Electricity has passed order on 01 December, 2020 in DFR No. 421 of 2020 & IA No. 1672 of 2020 IA No. 1671 of 2020 & IA No. 1670 of 2020 appeal against order dated 17.11.2020 passed by Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission in Case No. 179 of 2020 and has directed as under:

.....the Appellant will approach the Commission whereupon it would take up the Case no. 179 of 2020 further and take appropriate decision in accordance with law. Given the nature of the reliefs sought by the Appellant in the matter which has been revived before the State Commission by us by this order, it will be desirable that the Commission take a final view in the matter within four weeks of the Appellant approaching with the invoice.

The Petitioner WinIndia Ventures Pvt Ltd. vide its e-mail on 2 December 2020 has informed the Office of the Commission that it has raised invoice as directed by the APTEL.
