- (a) Take on record the Electricity Bill for January 2021 issued by JNPT and pending adjudication and final disposal of the present Application, pass necessary consequential directions in relation to execution of the Distribution Franchisee Agreement dated 05.01.2021 to ensure that Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust henceforth does not levy any charges including Electricity Service Charges of 20%, on Bharat Mumbai Container Terminals Private Limited which are contrary to the provisions of Electricity Act and over and above of the approved regulated tariff;
- (b) Pending adjudication and final disposal of the present Application, direct Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company to ensure that Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust to only recover tariff as per 'Annexure-I Tariff Schedule for FY 2020-21 to FY 2024-25 of the Tariff Order dated 30.03.2020 in Case no.322 of 2019 in compliance with direction the Order dated 24.05.2010 passed in Case No. 62 of 2009.
- (c) Issue appropriate directions against JNPT and MSEDCL for Production, disclosure and to bring on record:
  - (i) Settlement Terms concluded between the parties vide Minutes of Order dated 25.11.2016 as recorded in Order dated 25.11.2016 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay in Writ Petition No. 7092 of 2013 and

- (ii) Communications relating to execution of the Distribution Franchisee Agreement dated 05.01.2021;
- (d) pass any order and/or any such orders as this Hon'ble Commission may deem fit and proper under the facts and circumstances of the present case and in the interest of justice."
