Subject: Petition filed by Kalika Steel Alloys Pvt Ltd. & Ors (27) seeking appropriate orders/directions pertaining to the Revision/ Change in Contract Demand / extension of the earlier orders dated passed in Case No. 137 of 2020.

- **Case No. 25 of 2021**

The Petitioner Kalika Steel Alloys Pvt Ltd. & Ors (27) has filed this Petition on 15.3.2021 under Section 57, 61, 86 and 181 of the Electricity Act 2003 seeking appropriate orders/directions pertaining to the Revision/ Change in Contract Demand / extension of the earlier order dated 31 July 2020 in Case No. 137 of 2020.

- b) *That the Hon'ble Commission be pleased to extend the relaxation granted by the Hon'ble Commission vide Order dated 31 July 2020 in Petition No. 137 of 2020 for revision of Contract Demand be extended upto 31 March 2022.*
- c) *To pass appropriate directions as the facts and circumstances of the case demand and the Hon'ble MERC deem appropriate.*
