The prayer of main Petition is as under:

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- A. Direct the Respondent to make the payment (Principal along with LPS) for the amounts claimed by the Petitioner in the presentPetition within 3 days.
- B.Direct the Respondent to reduce the Contract Performance Guarantee in terms of the submissions made in the present Petition.
- C. Direct the Respondent to pay deemed availability charges for the period lower availability was declared/ to be declared on account of non-payment of dues by the Respondent.
- D. Direct the Respondent to issue its No-Objection for sale of uncontracted capacity to any third party.

- E. Pass such further Order(s) as this Hon'ble Commission may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the case.
