Subject: Petition of M/s Gro Solar Energy Private Limited under section 86(1)(f) of the Electricity Act 2003 for (i) approval of “Change in Law” and (ii) seeking an appropriate mechanism for grant of an appropriate adjustment/ compensation to offset financial/ commercial impact of change in law events on account of imposition of safeguard duty on solar cells/modules and increase in rate of basic customs duty on import of solar inverters in terms of Article 8 of the Power Purchase Agreement dated 31.10.2019 entered between M/s Gro Solar Energy Private Limited and Maharashtra State Power Generation Co. Ltd. for development of solar energy based power plant of 07 MW capacity at Village Degaon, Taluka Sindakhede, District. Dhule, Maharashtra.
